UPDATE:

It is a statutory duty of Aberdeen City Health and Social Care Partnership (ACHSCP) to publish an Annual Performance Report (APR). This Service Update informs the members of the IJB that the Annual Performance Report and its associated summary report is available to view online and that several copies are due to be distributed to key public areas in Aberdeen City to allow for perusal by members of the public who may find it difficult to, or may not wish to access the document in an online format. Key messages from the report will also be shared through social media over the coming days to highlight the APR and the work of ACHSCP Services. The APR will also be submitted to both NHS Grampian (NHSG) and Aberdeen City Council Boards to promote the report and the Partnership's performance.

The Public Bodies (Joint Working) (Scotland) Act 2014 provides guidance on what HSCPs are required to include in their APR. This includes a financial report and assurance of best value and the publication of the Integration Indicators which are published by Public Health Scotland on an annual basis. Also within the report as a means to demonstrate the performance of the ACHSCP against our Strategic Aims, there is an overview of the progress carried out against each entry within the Year 3 Delivery Plan for the 2022-2025 Strategic Plan.

This year, the graphics team from the University of Aberdeen assisted with the design of the APR to ensure that the document is presented professionally and that images used are of high quality. This also ensures consistency across branding elements.
