There will be -




• no electricity

Ready to eat foods



 Make sure your medical devices are charged and ready to use



 If you have to go outdoors, keep safe.



If your power goes off tell your support staff or care manager.

They will check to see that you are okay.

• Are deaf or hard of hearing



• Have a disability



• Live with children under five



• Are blind or partially sighted



• Have a chronic illness



 Use medical equipment/aids that need electricity
