What you can do to prepare for power cuts



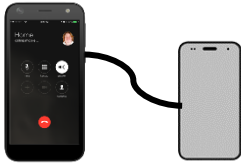
You can make up an emergency box that is ready to use.



- Flask



- Torch and batteries



- Power pack for your mobile



- Warm blanket



- Medicines



- Ready to eat foods



- Make sure your medical devices are charged and ready to use



- If you have to go outdoors, keep safe.



If your power goes off tell your support staff or care manager.

They will check to see that you are okay.



You can register for support with priority services if you:



- Are deaf or hard of hearing



- Have a disability



- Live with children under five



- Are blind or partially sighted



- Have a chronic illness



- Use medical equipment/aids that need electricity



- Are over 60
