

## Aberdeen Community Health & Care Village – update on services 23 March 2020

Services in Aberdeen Health Village have been moved out of the building to give the Health & Social Care Partnership increased capacity to deal with the Covid-19 outbreak.

Health Village-based staff have been placed on other duties elsewhere across health and social care in order to maintain workforce numbers in critical frontline services for the most vulnerable.

**Sexual Health** – Sexual health services have been moved to Foresterhill Health Centre on Westburn Road, where urgent cases are being dealt with.

**Dental Practice/Clinic** – Routine dental treatments at the Health Village have been suspended. For dental emergencies within working hours (8am-6pm), please phone 0345 45 65 990. Outwith normal hours, please phone NHS24 on 111.

**Dietetics, podiatry, speech & language therapy, physiotherapy** – There are no appointments at the Health Village. All services have been reduced. More information will be published as soon as possible.

**Cardiac rehabilitation, outpatients, minor surgery, radiology, endoscopy** – There are no appointments at the Health Village. All services have been reduced. More information will be published as soon as possible.

The closure of the Health Village to the general public also includes the café, the Health Point, the Carers Point and all Learning Centre meeting rooms.
