Respondents are very much in favour of increasing the use of electronic communications in primary care, particularly to receive appointment reminders by text and ordering repeat prescriptions online. However, they are less keen to replace face to face with a video call consultation.

A recent survey of Aberdeen City patients relating to their GP Services during Covid19, demonstrated that 96% of patients are happy to participate in remote consultations, including via telephone and video-call:



60% of people wouldn't mind having a telephone or video consultation. 17% would prefer face to face only.
